Tom,

In calendar year 2000, GHL was under contract to Applied Thermal Sciences for marketing and lobbying services. Pat Peterson and I were the point of contact for this work. The work was broken down into the two categories of marketing support and support on Capitol Hill or lobbying. The funding for the lobbying effort was \$500 per month and the remaining \$1500 was for engineering services and marketing.

It has been noted that in filing the Lobby Reporting Forms for the lobbying services provided to ATS in calendar year 2000, that a mistake was made. The amount of funding identified in the filing was listed as "more than \$10,000". In actuality it should have listed as "less than \$10,000" since the total invoiced amount for lobbying during each month period was only \$3,000.

**CONSULTING AGREEMENT NO. 98-16**  
between  
**GHL INCORPORATED**  
and  
**Applied Thermal Sciences, Inc.**  
(hereinafter referred to as **ATS**)


1. Services to be Rendered: As an independent contractor **GHL** Incorporated agrees to provide services to **ATS** which shall involve engineering service support (reference attached Statement of Work).
2. Fee: For the services rendered by **GHL** Incorporated, in accordance with this agreement **ATS** shall pay **GHL** at a rate of \$2,000.00 per month, plus expenses for the service noted above. Expenses include, but are not limited to, such items as long-distance telephone calls, postage, photocopying, filing and recording fees, and messengers. The estimated cost of expenses over the twelve month (12) life of this contract is \$4,000.
3. Term: This agreement shall be in effect on the date of execution, and shall continue in force for a period of twelve (12) months.

This agreement contains the entire agreement between **GHL** and **ATS** regarding this matter and fees, charges and expenses relating thereto. This agreement shall not be modified except by written agreement signed by **GHL** and **ATS**. Each provision of this agreement shall be severable and if any provision is determined by a court to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby.


