To Whom It May Concern:

Per a telephone conversation with a staff member of the Office of the Clerk, on December 16, 2002, my assistant was instructed that a brief letter should be written in order to have **Richard Doyle, President of the International Sleep Products Association (ISPA) added as a lobbyist and attach it to ISPA's 2002 year-end lobbying report.**
