To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the suggestion by Steve Pingeton of the Office of the Clerk of the House of Representatives, we have enclosed a lobbying registration form and activity report for a new client, the Next Generation Lighting Initiative Coalition, registration dated effective July 5, 2001.

As I explained to Mr. Pingeton, the lobbying activities reflected in the attached form LD-2 for this new client were initially contemplated to begin last July on behalf of the Optoelectronics Industry Development Association (OIDA), for whom we had already previously registered. Instead, our efforts were undertaken on behalf of the Next Generation Lighting Initiative Coalition, which also funded our efforts.

In these circumstances, Mr. Pingeton suggested that, rather than amending our filing on behalf of OIDA, a new LD-1 form be filed to reflect the identity of the new coalition for whom lobbying activities had been undertaken over the second half of the 2001 lobbying period. In so doing, we do not yet have a Senate ID number for this client.
