16	Lobbying Issues	<p>S. 1344, Patients' Bill of Rights Act of 1999; allows for "external reviews" of managed care treatment.</p> <p>H.R. 2998, Quality Care for the Uninsured Act of 1999 - allows patients to sue in state court health insurance plans for injuries caused by denial of care and establishes procedures for "Association Health Plans" (AHP's) and "Health Markets" (HM), which are multiple employer arrangements offering group plans under ERISA.</p> <p>H.R. 2723, Bipartisan Consensus Managed Care Improvement Act of 1999 - allows patients to sue in state court after exhausting external and internal appeals processes; creates tax incentives to help uninsured.</p> <p>H.R. 2824, Health Care Quality and Choice Act of 1999 - allows patients to sue in federal court, capping non-economic damages at \$500,000, or twice economic damages, whichever is less.</p> <p>H.R. 2878, Medical Privacy in the Age of New Technologies Act of 1999, would protect the privacy of health information for individuals in the age of genetics and other new technologies.</p> <p>Department of Health and Human Services proposed "Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Information"- would apply health plans, health care clearinghouses and certain health care providers maintaining or transmitting protected health information (PHI) in certain administrative and financial transactions</p>
