
To Whom It May Concern:

Although the Rongelap Atoll Local Government is a government entity (a political subdivision of the Republic of the Marshall Islands), this registration is being filed pursuant to the Lobbying Disclosure Act, and not under the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA). Under the terms of 48 U.S.C. 1905(f)(2), the Rongelap Atoll Local Government has submitted a letter of certification concerning the activities to be undertaken on its behalf by Fontheim International, LLC to the Office of Insular and International Affairs at the Department of the Interior, which in turn has transmitted that letter and accompanying information to the Chief of the Registration Unit, Internal Security Section, Criminal Division, at the Department of Justice.

That letter of certification was submitted in lieu of FARA registration to describe the anticipated activities of Fontheim International, which principally are matters other than those specified in FARA. In the letter, the Rongelap Atoll Local Government states its understanding and expectation that certification under 48 U.S.C. 1905(f)(2) is a legally permissible procedure for U.S. citizens covered by that provision in view of their employment by a government whose relationship to the United States is covered by the Compact of Free Association, as approved by the U.S. Congress under Public Law 99-239.

In light of the above, and the absence of FARA registration, Fontheim International now is registering under the LDA with respect to the anticipated lobbying activities that will constitute one element of its work for the Rongelap Atoll Local Government.
