
Dear Mr. Trandahl:

Reference is made to your letter dated April 4, 2000, which stated that, pursuant to a review of lobbying reports on file with the Legislative Resource Center, General Communications, Inc. ("GCI") did not submit lobbying disclosure reports for the period July 1, 1999 to December 31, 1999. Further reference is made to my letter dated April 14, 2000, in which I responded that GCI properly filed lobbying reports with the House of Representatives and the Senate for the period in question under House identification number "31801005" and Senate identification number "12631-12".

On April 19, 2000, I received a telephone call from Ms. Donna Downes of your office. Ms. Downes explained that GCI had not submitted lobbying reports for its in-house lobbyists for the period July 1, 1999 through December 31, 1999. Upon investigation, I have been informed by GCI that the company's in-house government relations operation changed personnel mid-way through the second half of 1999. Due to the change in personnel, it appears that the lobbying reports for the period in question were not filed.
