

ATTACHMENT A

TAX RELIEF: Fight against rolling back the Bush Tax Relief, marginal income tax rate reduction, reduction of excise tax hikes in the states, legislation related to capital access issues, capital gains tax reduction.

HEALTH CARE REFORM: Medical Savings Account expansion, tax credits for uninsured, tax equity for self-employed, small business pooling "patients' bill of rights," Medicare reform, prescription drug coverage, other health care issues dealing with small businesses.

REGULATORY REFORM: CAFÉ standards, regulatory accounting, budget, sound science, congressional review issues, and other regulatory issues affecting small businesses.

OTHER ISSUES: Telecommunications policy (Tauzin-Dingell bill), Internet tax moratorium, economic stimulus package, minimum wage issues, US energy policy, legal reform, global climate treaty and CO2 caps, campaign finance reform, antitrust activism, independent contractor rules, financial service issues, Social Security reform, trade agreements (Trade Promotion Authority), home-based businesses, national ID cards, and right to work legislation.
