Dear Ms. Gavin:

I am writing you today with a bit of an embarrassing problem. I filed my mid-year lobbying registrations in August as I should have, but recently had one returned because I screwed up the address. When I don't bring them in in person, I send them by Certified Mail with a Return Receipt. This entails having an address on the envelope as well as on the Return Receipt attached to the back of the envelope. I had one receipt come back (with no signature which the Post Office still cannot explain), but the other envelope came back marked "Not Deliverable as Addressed." The envelope was addressed to the House, but the Receipt was addressed to the Senate.

I obviously did not watch closely enough when the Post Office put the receipts and the envelopes together and, apparently, I'm just a bonthead. What can I say, except I apologize?

Without a signature on the receipt I did receive, I cannot tell whether your office or the Clerk of the House received my registrations on time, so I am sending identical letters to both of you along with additional copies of my registrations. I contacted both of your offices, but was told that no one could tell me whether you had received my reports for at least a month. In other words, one of you will now have duplicate copies and the other will only have one. Once you realize who only has one, please contact me and I can send you the still-sealed letter with the postmark on the original I tried to send so that you can be sure that I did (try to) meet the deadline. I apologize for this and can guarantee that this is a first — and it will be the last time this happens.
