To Whom It May Concern:

We write to alert you to the fact that a portion of the information included on Qualcomm Inc.'s timely 2006 mid-year Lobbying Disclosure Act filing does not appear on the electronic version of Qualcomm's report when retrieved and viewed from the Secretary of the Senate website. We assume that this is due to some technical malfunction, and Qualcomm wishes to ensure that the information on the electronic report is accurate. Therefore, we have attached a copy of the original report. This is not an amended report, as this is a copy of the version filed by Qualcomm on August 14, 2006. Qualcomm's filing receipt is also attached.

We wish to call to your attention the following categories of information missing from the electronic version. On page one, Sections 1) "Registrant Name" and 13) "Expenses" are blank. Regarding the Lobbying Activity pages, we note that the entire page for "Budget/ Appropriations" is missing from the electronic version. Moreover, in many cases on other Lobbying Activity pages, Section 16 of the electronic version does not include all lobbying issues as they appeared on Qualcomm's original report. Finally, Section 17 of the Lobbying Activity pages of the electronic version does not always list the federal agencies contacted.


