I am sending you the enclosed 2-page lobby report due to my complete frustration & inability to submit it to you electronically, as your web site says you now require. I started working on this in December, when I discovered your new reporting requirement. I went back to work on it in early January, and completed the report for at that time, but still needed the digital signature file & process to work before completing the report.

I fell ill with Influenza A and then a back infection that prevented me from working for very long time, through January & February, despite taking the medicine & 8 rounds of antibiotics.

As your 2/14 deadline approached, I obtained my digital signature & despite being sick, I still tried to complete your electronic process. My efforts came to an end when I followed your site instructions to delete my Adobe Acrobat software & use the old version 6.0.2. I use a quality computer & I am proficient with my PC, so the instructions caused

Thus, I am sending you my report in printed format. When my computer technician gets my PC working again I will please call your office to determine if you still want me to send it electronically at that time.

I apologize for having to send you this letter in hand-writing, but I only own one computer which now doesn't work.

I sure hope you will upgrade your election process to using the current versions of software in the future. Reverting to old versions sure seems antiquated and sure has caused me problems.
