Enclosed is our mid-year filing. Please note that the contact name has changed to John Terzano.

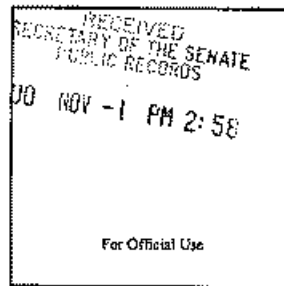


