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ADDENDUM for General Lobbying Issue Area: TRD - Trade (Domestic/Foreign)

Vietnam PNTR - HR 5602, S. 4595 - To authorize the extension of non-discriminatory treatment (normal trade relations) products of Vietnam;

Schumer Graham - S. 295 - To authorize appropriate action if the negotiations with the People's Republic of China re China's undervalued currency are not successful.

The Tax Relief and Health Care Act of 2006; HR 6111 - Extends the Generalized System of Preferences; the Andean Trade Preferences Act, the Miscellaneous Tariff Bill and the African Growth and Opportunity Act. Also enacts permanent normal relations with Vietnam.

Miscellaneous Tariff Bill, HR 6406 - To modify temporary certain rates of duty and make other technical amendments to trade laws, to extend certain trade preference programs and for other purposes

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
