*January 13, 2005:* meeting with Eric Stewart, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Department of Commerce, International Trade Administration. Topic of discussion – Europe and unilateral changes to IPPC standard for wood packaging material.

*February 8, 2005:* OSHA Fairness Coalition Meeting, NAM, NFIB, U.S. Chamber. Congressior Staff present: Greg Louer, Legislative Assistant to Congressman Charlie Norwood, Ninth Distri Georgia

*February 10, 2005:* Meeting with U.S. Trade Rep Dick White – Topic for discussion: Debarking requirements for Europe

*March 7, 2005:* Meeting with OSHA, Richard Fairfax, Dir. Of Enforcement Programs – Topic: Need for national consistency in enforcement for our industry.

*May 25, June 1 & 8, 2005* – e-mail correspondence with Kristine Poptanich, legislative aide to U.S. Senator Mike DeWine, regarding Europe's proposed standard requiring imports on wood packaging to be debarked. Sent background material on issue, then at her request sent draft letters for Sen. DeWine to send to Senate colleagues and on to new secretaries of Commerce, Trade & Agriculture to make them familiar with the topic.
