H.R. 4146: "Hurricanes Rita and Wilma Financial Services Relief Act of 2005" - A bill to facilitate recovery from effects of Hurricane Rita and Hurricane Wilma by providing greater flexibility for, and temporary waivers of or requirements and fees imposed on, depository institutions, credit unions, and Federal regulatory agencies, and for other purposes.

H.R. 4100: "The Louisiana Recovery Corporation Act" - A bill to establish the Louisiana Recovery Corporation as an independent establishment in the executive branch whose primary mission shall be the economic stabilization and redevelopment of areas within Louisiana that were devastated or significantly distressed by Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita.
