Dear Mr. Potter:

This will confirm our understanding concerning this firm serving as Legislative Counsel to Canton-Potsdam Hospital on the Federal level commencing on January 1, 2002 until December 31, 2002. The representation will be on specific issues identified jointly by Canton-Potsdam Hospital and Wilson, Elser, Moskowitz, Edelman & Dicker LLP.
