I am enclosing two documents related to my advocacy work on behalf of the Medicare Payment Coalition for Frail Beneficiaries (MPCFB). The work of this Coalition includes Medicare payment and risk adjustment research, policy development and advocacy. Until January of 2003, the MPCFB was sponsored by the National Chronic Care Consortium's National Resource Center for Chronic Care Integration (Senate ID 50216-51; House ID 34676003). In January of this year, the National Chronic Care Consortium (NCCC) assumed responsibility for sponsoring the Medicare Payment Coalition for Frail Beneficiaries (Senate ID 50216-24; House ID 34676001).

The first document I am attaching to reflect this transfer in sponsorship of the MPCFB is a form to terminate my registration for the National Resource Center for Chronic Care Integration since I will no longer be representing this group.
