H.R. 2034/S. 1218: To provide quality, affordable health care for all Americans by allowing all residents to enroll in Medicare.

S. 1408: To improve quality in health care by providing incentives for adoption of modern information technology and to facilitate the adoption of health information technology (HIT) among health care providers.

S. 1544: To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to improve the quality and efficiency of health care, to provide public with information on provider and supplier performance, and to enhance the education and awareness of consumers evaluating health care services through the development and release of reports based on Medicare enrollment, claims, and assessment data.
