Monitor Issues Related to Hospitals and Reimbursements. Medicare: NJHA opposed provisions in FY08 Inpatient Prospective Payment System rule (IPPS) that included more than \$22 billion in cuts to Medicare payments over five years. These cuts included reductions to hospital operating payments in the form of a behavioral offset, cuts in capital add-on payments to large urban hospitals, and indirect medical education payments that flow through Medicare capital payments.
