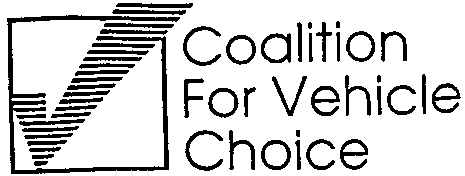

With regard to notifying your members we will provide additional guidance in the next few weeks.

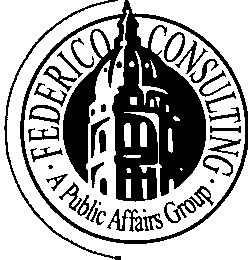
