



Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 1605(7), this letter is to provide you with notice of noncompliance with the following requirements of the Lobbying Disclosure Act (LDA), 2 U.S.C. § 1601, et seq.:

You are required by law to provide an appropriate response within **60 days** of the date of this letter [2 U.S.C. § 1605(8)]. Failure to do so will result in referral of this matter to the **United States Attorney for the District of Columbia** for legal action. Please be advised that violators of the Lobbying Disclosure Act are subject to a **civil fine** of up to \$50,000.
