Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter is in response to your letter to the League of Conservation Voters (LCV) (ID: 71278-12) about our mid-year 2002 Lobbying Report.

We have reviewed our records and consulted with our attorneys to determine whether our report is an accurate reflection of our lobbying expenses. We believe that we have underreported the actual expenses associated with our lobbying activities and have enclosed an amended report for the 2002 Mid-Year. This amended report includes staff salaries (including benefits), overhead and direct expenses and is based on each professional staffer tracking her percentage of time devoted to lobbying activity.

We want to point out that although LCV's lobbying efforts are extensive in terms of the issues we cover as well as the legislation, our expenses are limited due to the type of lobbying activity we primarily engage in. LCV only employs in-house lobbyists and the majority of our lobbying efforts consist of letters to members of Congress rather than the conventional lobbying that many individuals and organizations report that involve extensive personal contact with members of Congress.

Our lobbying efforts are also cyclical. In an election year, LCV devotes limited resources to lobbying, whereas in a non-election year, LCV spends more resources on lobbying than in an election year. We expect our Year-End 2002 report to reflect little activity (under \$10,000 in expenses) and our 2003 reports to reflect the increased in lobbying activities.

Our attorney has advised us that LCV and our lobbyists should register and file reports required, although at times (primarily Year-End reports in election years) expenses will be less than \$10,000.
