On May 8, 2000 your office sent to a former partner of this firm, Brad C. Johnson document entitled "Second Notice of Non-Receipt" which stated that a report for the period 1, 1999 to December 31, 1999 had not been filed. (A copy is enclosed for your reference. Johnson resigned from the firm on August 6, 1999 and no other person in this firm, including myself, has performed any lobbying services on behalf of the Mortgage Bankers Association since his departure. It is our understanding that the Mortgage Bankers Association followed Johnson to his new law firm, Duane Morris, and entered into a new retainer agreement with that firm. We have no record in this law firm of receiving any prior Notice of Non-Receipt.

This firm takes the requirements of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 very seriously and would not knowingly disregard them. We believe the failure to timely file either a termination notice or the periodic report in question results from some of the normal administrative confusion surrounding the departure of a partner and the transitioning of his work to another law firm and regret any delay in filing the enclosed Termination Report.
