Dear Sir:

The attached Lobbying Report (Form LD-2) is being filed late, on behalf of ICO Global Communications Services. Normally, we have filed these Reports for the second half of the year (July 1 – December 31) by mid-February of the following year.

However, the Washington Regional Office of ICO was closed down in February, and all the employees—save this one—were either dismissed or transferred back to ICO Headquarters, in London. This action was a consequence of certain changes that had taken place in connection with the refinancing of ICO by Craig McCaw, in connection with ICO's emergence from Chapter 11 bankruptcy last year. ICO, working in parallel with McCaw's Teledesic, at the moment is undergoing a two-stage change in its ownership and control. At the conclusion of this two-stage process, ICO will become a wholly owned subsidiary of New ICO Global Communications (Holdings) Limited ("New ICO"); New ICO will merge with and into a wholly owned subsidiary of ICO-Teledesic Global Limited ("ITGL") and become the surviving corporation; and Craig O. McCaw will retain *de facto* and *de jure* control of ITGL and New ICO.


