Please accept my apology for this report being late. Hopefully my explanation for tardiness will also excuse any penalties or fines for this report.

This is a small office - normally 2 1/2 people. In April 2000 the Executive Director left for another position - making this a 1 1/2 person office until a replacement could be found. The replacement arrived January 15, 2001. As the Business Manager, I prepared all Lobby Disclosure Reports for the Executive Director. Unfortunately, on November 25, 2000 I was admitted through Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital Emergency Room with Stage 4 Ovarian Cancer. Surgery followed on November 29th with a total hysterectomy and other minor removals. I was released from the hospital on December 10th with my first chemotherapy treatment on December 13th. Following completion of 4 rounds of platinum series chemotherapy, I was given the opportunity to participate in an experimental procedure known as stem cell transplantation. Hopefully by the end of May 2001 -I will have completed this procedure and hopefully will remain cancer free from this time forward.
