Please find enclosed Procter & Gamble's semiannual Lobbying Disclosure Act Form 2 for the second half of calendar year 2002.

In addition to reporting the lobbying activities of Procter & Gamble, we are also reporting on the enclosed Form LD-2 the activities of employees of foreign subsidiaries of Procter & Gamble that occurred during the previous semiannual reporting period. All such activities on behalf of foreign subsidiaries fall within the scope of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938 ("FARA"), 22 U.S.C. § 611 et seq. Because those activities were carried out for and on behalf of a non-U.S. incorporated entity, the activities of the entity's a in the United States are eligible to be reported under the LDA, Section 3(h) of FARA 22 U. §§ 613(h) and 611(b)(3).

When activities of the agents of its foreign subsidiaries are in the future subject to FARA and, pursuant to Section 3(h) of FARA, are eligible for reporting under the LDA, Procter & Gamble intends to continue in its filings with your Office the practice noted above of including on its semiannual Form LD-2 filings such activities that occurred during the previous semiannual reporting period.
