H.R. 5040, the United States Toxic Mold Safety and Protection Act - directs the EPA, CDC and NIH to jointly study the health effects of mold. Requires the Director FEMA to establish and carry out a toxic mold insurance program, with priority for one-to-four family residential properties, and establishes in the Treasury Department a National Toxic Mold Hazard Insurance Fund.
