UNITEDHEALTH GROUP CONFIRMS MERGER COMPLETION

Minneapolis, Minnesota (August 4, 2004) – UnitedHealth Group (NYSE: UNH) confirmed today, in response to media coverage of a lawsuit filed by the Medical Society of New Jersey (MSNJ) challenging UnitedHealth Group's merger with Oxford Health Plans, Inc., (Oxford) that the acquisition was completed July 29, 2004 after the receipt of all necessary regulatory approvals, including from New Jersey's Commissioner of Banking and Insurance, as further indicated in the Commissioner's news release dated August 2, 2004.
