

Pension issues related to employer-sponsored ERISA qualified retirement plans. Made contact on a number of pension bills, but principal activities were devoted to two main stream bipartisan pension reform bills HR 1102 and S.741. Also have devoted time to several pension related provisions contained in pending bankruptcy reform legislation. Pension reforms are now included in pending major tax legislation (HR 2488), and bankruptcy reform legislation has passed the House, but the Senate has yet considered (S.625, HR 833), the first session of the 106th Congress.
