ADDENDUM for General Lobbying Issue Area: RET - Retirement

H.R. 192 Social Security Beneficiary Tax Reduction Act. Legislation to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to 1993 increase in taxes on Social Security benefits. The issue of reducing taxes on Social Security benefits.
