(Bill Tauzin) - Regarding the transition to Digital Television - assisted in lobbying and preparing testimony related to how cable MSO's activities in opposing a competitive set-top box market was a factor in delaying transition as well as pointing out weaknesses in this proposed bill. FCC - CS Docket No. 97-80 concerning navigation devices (set top boxes, etc.) CS Docket No. 02-52 CC/CB/GN Docket No. 00-185 re prohibiting cable modem subsidies. Lobbied to expand competition in the set top box and cable modem markets in opposition to cable industry's monopolistic practices.
