Medicaid: DSH re-couplement issue, impacts New Jersey hospitals that were contacted by Medicare's fiscal intermediary to repay past years of disproportionate share hospital payments; Advocated to stop CMS from pursuing its January 18th proposed rule, which would reduce Medicaid funding by what the Administration estimates is \$3.8 billion over five years and urge for a moratorium on CMS from moving forward with the Medicaid rule on intergovernmental transfers (IGTs) and certified public expenditures (CPEs); prevent CMS from working on any rules related to eliminating payments for graduate medical education (GME) under the Medicaid program. Medicare: Make permanent a policy for computing and applying an imputed rural wage index floor for each all-urban States; Extend Section 508 of the MMA that allows for geographic reclass; Oppose proposed cuts to Medicare and Medicaid spending by more than \$100 billion over five years in the FY08 Budget; Opposing provisions in the 2008 Medicare inpatient prospective payment system proposed rule (IPPS) that would cut payments to hospitals by \$25 billion over five years; Support S.543/H.R.1459, bill to
